SCOPE OF THE COMPETITION:

Part One: Bought to competition - Teams will be required to paint two 18"X24" flat sheet metal panels (one panel is to e basecoat/clearcoat color only, and the second panel is to be a custom painted panel using a basecoat/clearcoat system). Also, the students will be required to provide a picture portfolio for each panel showing the different steps and provide his/her own display system.

Part Two: On-site - The contestant will be required to repair a fender at the State Fair using basic hand tools. The fender will be prepped for the application of 2K Primer.

SAFETY STATEMENT:

All entries must present at registration, the attached Safety Statement signed by students and advisors. Safety glasses required.

NUMBER OF CONTESTANTS:

This is a two-member team competition.

Part One: The first team member will complete the paint project at his home school, present the project using the picture photos in a maximum of one-minute presentation explaining the procedure used in finishing the panels.

Part Two: The second team member will complete the sheet metal repairs at the State Fair. Schools may enter a first year team only, a second year team only, or a first and second year team. Each school can enter two teams.

AWARDS: Awards will be presented at the Contest Area.

Awards will be given for each (2) part of the overall contest. The two scores will be combined to determine the overall winning team.

First, Second and Third for Part 1 – Display of panels pre-produced

First, Second and Third for Part 2 - On site panel

First, Second and Third for Overall – Combined scores for Parts 1 and 2

ENTRY FEE: \$40.00 per team entering the competition. The registration must be accompanied by a check. Please register on-line at www.skillsusava.org, go to Event, State Fair and then to Competitions.

DEADLINE: Schools must register the number of teams by September 22, 2017. Contestant names must be submitted to the State SkillsUSA Specialist by September 22, 2017. Substitutions may be made the day of the competition.

- Participants must have a Student Competition Ticket (\$6.15) to enter the Fairgrounds unless they are already at the Fair for another competition.
- <u>Teachers are responsible for ordering tickets online by September</u> 22, 2017 <u>directly from the State Fair Ticket</u> <u>Office using a State Fair Student Competition Ticket Order Form, which can be found on-line at www.skillsusava.org under 'State Fair'</u>
- <u>Tool drop off, schools must have a 30 min. drop pass for vehicle entry, or contestants will have to carry in their</u> tool boxes to the contest area. Passes maybe ordered when ordering State Fair tickets.
