First place winners will receive \$100 and an Eastern States Exposition ribbon. **Second place winners** will receive \$60 and an Eastern States Exposition ribbon. **Third place winners** will receive \$40 and an Eastern States Exposition ribbon.

JUDGING CRITERIA: Appearance, Consistency, Flavor, Texture, and Overall Quality

RULES

- Entry forms may be emailed, faxed or mailed in, but must be <u>received</u> by September 7, 2017.
- 2. Eligible exhibitors meeting all the rules of the contest may receive reimbursement for two (2) entry tickets and \$10 for parking per household.
- 3. Contestants of any age are welcome to participate with a limit of **one entry per person**.
- 4. Recipes must be typed on an 8 ½" x 11" pies of white paper. Contestant's name, address and phone number must be included on the back only. The recipes should be original and unpublished of which you are the owner.
- 5. You are to submit one dozen (12) or more pieces of candy on a paper plate
- 6. All participants must be present to receive awards at noon.
- 7. Mixes and prepared foods may not be used in recipes.
- 8. No sauces allowed.
- 9. No refrigeration is available.
- 10. Entries must be made with Domino Sugar—proof of purchase is required: a UPC from package or cash register receipt should be stapled to the back of your recipe. Do not send the UPC or cash register receipt with your entry form.
- 11. All winners must sign a Domino Sugar recipe release form. All recipes become the property of Domino Sugar and Eastern States Exposition and may be edited, adapted, copyrighted, published and used for publicity, promotion and/or advertising at their discretion without compensation to the contestant.

Entries are to be brought to the New England Center, Door 2 between 8:30am and 9:30am on Thursday, September 21. Judging begins at 10:30 am. Once judging commences no entries will be allowed. Candies are to remain on display until 5pm. Only the judges will be allowed to sample candies.

Candies will be released after 5:00 PM. Candies left after 6 PM will become the property of Eastern States Exposition.

Entrants may be disqualified at the discretion of judges and Eastern States Exposition Management.
