# Things to Do in The OC

A trip to Orange County doesn't have to break the bank. There's plenty to do and see in The OC that doesn't cost a dime! The California Welcome Center should be your first stop if you need help planning your OC adventure. Centrally located in Buena Park, the center's friendly staff can get you free brochures on all California attractions, directions, discounts, maps and more – everything you need to maximize your time and minimize your spending.



For a truly Southern California experience, start your day at the beach. Huntington Beach is a sun-lover's wonderland with miles of soft sand, volleyball nets, fire pits and surfers galore. Bring your sunscreen, sunglasses and snacks and you are in for a day of relaxation. The Orange County coast is also a great place to explore tide pools. Check the low tide schedule and then head to Heisler Park Reserve or Treasure Island Beach, both in the town of Laguna Beach, to see tons of underwater creatures like sea anemones, sea urchins and crabs. Follow it up with a visit to the **Pacific Marine Mammal Center** where you can learn how this organization rehabilitates and releases injured and sick sea animals.

Travel back in time and take advantage of the many historic buildings and museums in Buena Park that offer free tours like the **Whitaker-Jaynes House**, the **Bacon House** and the **Stage Shop Hotel** – currently home to a California Welcome Center.





If you want to go even farther back in time, the Clark Interpretive Center in Ralph Clark Regional Park houses tons of ice age fossils including a 9-million-year-old baleen whale skeleton. The park also has picnic tables, walking paths and three dinosaur-themed playgrounds.

American history is featured at **Knott's Independence Hall** – an exact replica of the Philadelphia landmark – where you can hear an audio retelling of the dramatic debate that led to the drafting of the Declaration of Independence and the creation of the United States of America. Admission is free and you can even get a free hour of parking in the Knott's MarketPlace Parking Lot.



Breathe in the (free) fresh air at one of the area's many parks as you take in the varied and beautiful landscape of Orange County. Laguna Canyon Wilderness Park in Laguna Beach will give you scenic coastal views and 42 miles of hiking trails. Head to the park's Nix Nature Center to learn about the

Native American population that once called this area their home. If you are bringing kids with you, ask a ranger for the scavenger hunt for Mary's Trail – a half-mile loop near the center.

You may be surprised to find the majestic rock formations of Red Rock Canyon in Whiting Ranch Wilderness Park. The 4-mile roundtrip hike through the sandstone canyon that was once under water rewards you with scenic vistas and plenty of wildlife along the way. For a different view, explore Southern California's largest redwood grove at Carbon Canyon Regional Park. Take the mile-long nature trail to see the majestic trees, then play on the playground or catch some fish in the park's four-acre lake.


Continue your outdoor education at the Fullerton Arboretum, the county's largest botanical garden. Kids (and kids at heart) are encouraged to touch and explore at the



Sniff n' Seek Garden and the Weird and Wonderful Do-Touch Garden. If learning about the latest trends in health and nutrition are more your speed, then sign up for a free 90-minute tour of the **Nutrilite** 

**Experience Center** in Buena Park. Here you can meet the scientists behind the Nutrilite brand and ask questions about supplements and the benefits of phytonutrients.

Got some city kids in your crew? Take them to the **Centennial Farm** at the OC Fair and Event Center in Costa Mesa. This threeacre working farm was designed to teach youth about agriculture and its importance in daily life. Visit the fruit and vegetable gardens, then meet the pigs, chickens, cattle and goats that make their homes there.



Another great stop for families is the Kids Rock Playground at Orange Country Great Park in Irvine. This park teaches about the water cycle and offers plenty of climbing opportunities and even some water misters which are much needed on a hot day. Afterwards, swing by the park's **Farm + Food Lab** to discover some innovative gardening and composting ideas.

# Frequently Asked Questions

# Q: How close is Disneyland® from Buena Park and how can I get there?

A: Disneyland® is a short 5 mile drive on the Interstate 5 Freeway. Most Buena Park hotels offer complimentary shuttle service to local attractions including Disneyland®. Check with your hotel at the time of reservation for details.

# Q: What are the closest airports to fly into?

A: There are several airports to choose from in the Southern California region. Los Angeles Airport (LAX) is approximately 28 miles away and is the best option for those traveling internationally. For domestic flights, John Wayne Airport (SNA) is less than 20 miles away and Long Beach Airport (LGB) is a mere 13 miles away.

# Q: What destinations does John Wayne Airport offer direct and international flights to/from?

A: John Wayne Airport (SNA) offers over 20 direct flights from Chicago, Newark, Houston, Dallas/Fort Worth, Seattle, Phoenix, Salt Lake City, Las Vegas, Denver, Portland, Oakland, San Jose, San Francisco, Sacramento, Atlanta and more. John Wayne Airport also offers international flights to/from select cities in Mexico and Canada.

# Q: What is the closest beach to Buena Park?

A: The closest beach to Buena Park is Huntington Beach also known as "Surf City USA" Take a short 10 mile drive south along Beach Boulevard and you will end at the ocean along Pacific Coast Highway.





# Q: When is Knott's Soak City Waterpark open?

**A:** The Waterpark is located across from the theme park and is open during the summer season (May through mid-September).

# Q: Where do I get discounted attraction tickets?

A: Save time and money by getting your discounted attraction tickets at Southern California Ticket & Tour Center, located inside the California Welcome Center. Conveniently open 7 days a week, they offer a variety of tickets and tours. Don't wait in long lines - get your tickets ahead of time at the Center!

# Q: When is the best time to visit Buena Park?

A: With Southern California's famous year-round sunshine, it's always a great time to visit Buena Park. July and August are the busiest and hottest months of the year. During October, guests travel from all over to attend the largest Halloween event, Knott's Scary Farm. For the lowest rates on hotels and attractions, November through February are the ideal travel months.

# Q: What should I bring on my trip?

A: The dress code in California is always casual.

Travelers should pack lightweight clothing for the day and layered clothing for the evening. Don't forget to bring your sunscreen, hats and bathing suit. If you are traveling from outside the United States, bring a compatible power adapter and a copy of your visa/ passport.

Named one of OC's best chefs, Spencer Kim, owner of Spencer's Bistro, refined his culinary skills at Roy's and went on to open the Tommy Bahama restaurant in Laguna Beach before opening his own unassuming but over-the-top delicious restaurant closer to home. Read on to discover why you should swing by his Buena Park restaurant to see what's on his seasonal menu!



What made you decide to open Spencer's Bistro? When I started this career, I knew that's where I wanted to end up - to have my own restaurant. That way I could put my name on dishes and share what I know with everybody else.

How do you define your cuisine? I would say that the base cuisine is European, as that gives me a broad canvas to work off of. But then there will be hints here and there of Asian, South American or Indian influences. I try to sneak that in. The neighborhood around here is very diverse so I didn't want to do just traditional Italian in the hopes that it would capture a much more diverse group.

Why did you decide to go for fast casual style? When I opened my own restaurant, I wanted it to be more accessible to people, and one of the biggest things would be the cost aspect of it. Growing up, my parents had that influence on me -that good food should be affordable and enjoyed by everyone in a comfortable setting.

What menu item is the most "Instagrammable"? If I had to pick one dish I'd probably go with the Greek Grilled Chicken. People are always commenting that it's a beautiful dish.


What's your top cooking tip for the at-home cook? Have no fear. The reason why dishes come out the way they do at good restaurants is strictly because of repetition. The first time we learn to make a dish will be the hardest because we don't have it ingrained in us. But the more we practice the dish, the easier it becomes as it gives us the time to think about shortcuts or tricks.

What can we look forward to eating at Spencer's Bistro this *Vear?* There are a few dishes that come to mind. One is our salmon pesto pasta. I've been strictly using home-grown basil to make the pesto and when we run out, that's when I'll stop putting it on the menu. Every year we have people that are just waiting for my basil to grow out.
