Entry Dates

Friday, August 25, 2017 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM Saturday, August 26, 2017 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM

- 1. Entries must be the work of the exhibitors only and must not have been entered in a previous New Mexico State Fair, or any other competition.
- 2. Entries must be predominantly made of wood.
- 3. Judges may reject or reclassify entries. Decisions of the judges are final.
- 4. Entries must be one of a kind; no multiple production items are allowed. Multiple items may be entered only if they are a set (e.g., a pair of end tables) on a space available basis. Small items must be attached to a display or secured in a case.
- 5. If the exhibitors name is on the entry, the exhibitor must conceal it to preserve anonymity during judging. No price tags may be attached.
- 6. Only one entry per class.
- 7. Large items will be displayed in an open area on a space available basis. Models of buildings that require display on a table are limited to 3 x 3 foot footprint.
- 8. Items that require hanging shall have a permanent, secure attachments for hanging.
- 9. Exhibits will be accepted for display only (i.e. not to be judged) on a space available basis.

Woodworking Sections 502-506

Section 502 - Youth	12 years and under who have not won a Youth Best of Show Award in previous years
Section 503 - Novice	One with less than two years and have not won a Best of Show as a Novice in a previous year
Section 504 – Intermediate	One who has more than two years experience but less than five years experience and have not won a Best of Show as Intermediate in a previous year
Section 505 – Advanced	One with more than 5 years experience and have not won a Best of Show as Advanced in a previous year

One who during the past 3 years has sold or has been paid as an instructor or amateurs who consider themselves highly advanced.

Classes 1-11 Each Section will Compete in the Following Classes

- 1. Accessories examples lamps, bookends, items intended for display and other art items not fitting any other class
- 2. Cabinets, sideboard, chest of drawers, etc. Typically involving fitted drawers and/or door
- 3. Chair
- 4. Cradles, cribs, blanket chests
- 5. Fretwork
- 6. Inlay, marquetry, intarsia, etc.
- 7. Miscellaneous items not fitting any other class. Tools, jigs, and tool boxes
- 8. Simple benches, stools, tables, display shelves, etc.
- 9. Small boxes, jewelry boxes, game chests, etc.
- 10. Toys, puzzles, riding toys, etc.
- 11. Wooden scale models

Ribbon Awards

1st Place - Blue 2nd Place - Red 3rd Place - White

Best of Show - Rosette - Purple
