Participants, by their mere participation in the parade agree to hold harmless Washington County Fair, Washington County and all parade officials and organization officers from any and all liability regarding any accident or injury while in transit to the parade, during the parade or returning home after the parade, this includes, but is not limited to, items thrown from parade entries.
