#### **ELIGIBILITY:**

• Exhibitor must be 8 years old by September 1, 2017. Exhibitor must be a current member of Osceola County 4–H, FFA, or FCCLA and may enter all open class shows.

## **HEALTH REQUIREMENTS:**

• All animals will be required to meet the guidelines set by the State of Florida, Department of Agriculture.

#### **JUDGING:**

- Only Blue Ribbon exhibits will be eligible for Best in Class, Grand Champion and Reserve Champion places. Exhibitors must be present during judging or prior arrangements must be made with the committee, otherwise no premiums will be paid. An animal can only be shown in one class.
- Birds are judged according to the American Poultry Association (APA) Standard
  of Perfection and the American Bantam Association (ABA) of Perfection. Birds
  recognized by the ABA will be placed in classifications of the APA. Birds not
  currently recognized as a breed by these Associations can be still be shown in
  Grooming or Commercial Classes.

#### **DRESS CODE:**

 Blue or Black jeans, Long Sleeve White collared shirt or Club T-shirts tucked in, boots or closed toed shoes and belt.

#### AC/HEAT:

There is no AC or Heat. BLANKETS ON TOP OF CAGES must be REMOVED by 10:00
 AM or earlier if the fair opens before 10:00 AM. Blankets cannot be put on cages
 before 8:00 PM (this includes tarps). You may store them folded in the exhibitor
 feed area.

#### SIGNAGE:

 ONLY SIGNAGE APPROVED BY THE FAIR OFFICE AND/OR COMMITTEES ARE PERMITTED ON CAGES OR PENS. Please see a Poultry Committee Member if you have any questions.



#### **REGISTRATION:**

- All animals must be registered **ONLINE**.
- If unsure of breed you must bring to the January Workshop.
- YOU MUST ATTEND ONE OF THE HANDS ON BATHING/PEST CONTROL WORKSHOPS TO BE IN OCTOBER OR JANUARY (see calendar for exact dates & times). Please bring one bird per family and any grooming materials for hands on workshop.
- In the event, you need to change your entry, you must email the chairperson no later than January 20, 2018.
- Parent & youth will need to sign the acknowledgement form at check in (a separate table will be set up to speed up check in)
- If at judging, birds are found to be in wrong class, they will be moved to grooming. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

#### ANIMAL CARE:

 Exhibitors will be required to feed and water their own animals and bring their own feed. All animals must be cared for by the exhibitor. This includes feeding, watering, and cleaning beds and pens. Exhibitors will need to bring feed each day for their animals. \*\*Please DO NOT feed anyone else's bird. Not all birds are on same type of food or feeding schedule.



- It is not the responsibility of the KVLS Committee to feed and/or water animals.
- If an exhibitor fails to feed and/or water their animals for 24 hours the exhibitor will be asked to remove their animal.
- Please clean out and under pens daily. Remember these exhibits are for the public to view, let's show them something we can be proud of.
- Both adults & youth are to sign in and out of tent each time you go in to feed, water, clean, barn duty, or anytime you spend time in the tent. \*\*Must be signed by the youth and parent on separate lines.

#### HANDLING:

- No animal will be exhibited in competition that cannot be properly handled by the exhibitor.
- Animals that cannot be handled properly will be disqualified and premiums forfeited.

#### **SHOW LIMITATION:**

• There must be a minimum of five animals per species to have a show (unless otherwise stated).

#### CHECKIN:

- Youth and adults are not to move birds from the assigned cages.
- On Friday, early morning the Poultry Committee will move birds to be in the correct breed section and to condense cage space. If you wish to move your own bird you will need to be present when we move the birds.
- Eggs will be collected by the Poultry Committee at various times during the day and will be disposed of at the discretion of the fair. SORRY NO EGGS WILL BE LEFT IN THE CAGES.

#### **CHECKOUT:**

- Animals removed before checkout time and date will result in forfeiture of premium money.
- Animals not picked up may be adopted out at the discretion of the Poultry Committee at no liability to the fair.
- ABSOLUTELY NO VECHICLE WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE FAIR AREA. THE FAIR IS STILL OPEN TO THE PUBLIC AND THEREFORE IS NOT ALLOWED. Vehicles may be pulled into the extension parking lot. Once you are ready to load up only one vehicle at a time may pull up to the side gate for loading. Once loaded please move your vehicle to allow others to pull up.
- ANY ITEMS LEFT BEHIND become the property of the fair and will be used, disposed of, or donated at our choosing. No liability is assumed by the fair.



#### **PREMIUMS:**

• All premiums will be mailed to the exhibitors after the fair. Please allow up to 6 weeks.

\*\*Your animal area must be clean (inside/underneath/around) at all times, including checkout time. If not clean, premiums will be forfeited\*\*

### **POULTRY RULES AND REGULATIONS**

#### **Health Requirements:**

- All poultry are required to be free of disease, parasites and mites. Poultry not free may be disqualified. All poultry will be inspected and tested at check-in.
  - o ANY BIRDS IN QUESTION WILL BE SENT HOME.
- If a bird gets sick during the fair please notify a committee member. They will notify the Chair or Co-Chair. Only persons authorized to send a bird home sick and not forfeit premiums are the Chair, Co-Chair, or a veterinarian (written proof to be provided to fair office). We do not want sick animals at the fair nor do we want you to lose your premiums.

## Animal Eligibility:

- Birds need to be at least 6 months old by show time. Exhibitors will need to be able to handle their birds.
- No classes are provided for Guineas or Peacocks.

#### **Entries Allowed:**

• A total of six (6) birds allowed per exhibitor. May enter three (3) in addition if part of the Production Poultry Program.



## Judging:

- Poultry will be judged on tables. (Please attend Poultry workshops offered through KVLS or your individual programs to learn how to show poultry on tables.)
- Exhibitors will not be permitted to give anything to any Judge during any show.

- Birds will arrive at the same time as the other poultry and betested.
- The child will present their best three (3) of the chicks for a trio, which they bought from the Committee for the fair.
- All poultry are required to be free of disease, parasites and mites. Poultry no free will be disqualified. All poultry will be tested at checkin.
- The Trio will be cooped together in one pen.
- The Poultry Judge in their pen will judge birds during the Poultry Show as its own Division.
- The Trio will be judged as a group with Premium and Ribbons:
  - a. Blue ---\$15.00
  - b. Red -- \$9.00
  - c. White --- \$6.00
  - d. The Trio will be judged as a group for Grand and Reserve. Premium: Grand \$50, Reserve \$25.
- Any additional birds may be shown in the Youth Poultry Show in theappropriate class.
- Skill-a-thon & Showmanship contests are highly recommended. Contest is on the 2nd Saturday of the fair at 9AM, awards are at 3PM.

## **SECTION 10 | EGG DÉCORATING CONTEST**

- See Poultry Rules for premium information.
- The top 3 in each division, Junior, Intermediate, and Senior divisions will receive rosettes and 1st place in each division will receive additional \$5 premium.
- Only one egg per exhibitor.
- Must be turned in at time of check-in on Thursday at same time as birds.
- Eggs MUST be blown out.
- Eggs may be decorated with paint, feathers, paper, crayons, etc.
- Eggs must be decorated by exhibitor.
- Please check with your organization leaders or Poultry Committee for safe way to handle egg.
- Exception is in the Fair Theme Class, exhibitor may use 1-3 eggs and design MUST be an interpretation of this year's fair theme **#AGVOCATE**.

#### **SECTION 11 | EGG SHOW SECTION**

#### **ENTRIES:**

All exhibitors must be entered in the Poultry Show.

- 1. There is no entry fee.
- 2. There shall be no identification marks on the eggs but an Egg Information Card must be attached to each carton. EGG INFORMATION CARD WILL BE AVAILABLE AT the January Workshop and at check in.
  - **a.** Eggs must be turned in at time of check-in with a completed Egg Information Card attached.
- 3. Limit One Dozen eggs per exhibitor.

#### **EGG SPECIFICATIONS**

- 1. All eggs shown must be chicken eggs and selected by the exhibitor. Exhibitor's flocks need not produce them.
- 2. Eggs are not to be purchased from a grocery store.
- 3. All eggs must be entered as a single dozen. An Egg Information Card must be filled out and attached to the carton.
- 4. There will be a Pee Wee (X-Small), Small, Medium, Large Extra Large and Jumbo Class. If enough eggs are entered the Poultry Committee reserves the right to break the class down further by color --- white, brown and for blue/green eggs.
- 5. A dozen eggs of minimum average weight for the class shall receive as many points, other things being equal as a dozen eggs of maximum average weight for the class.
- 6. Eggs will be judged on interior as well as exterior quality.
- 7. Eggs should be clean and stain free.
- 8. Please attend workshop to learn about choosing, cleaning, and displaying eggs.

#### **DISPLAY AND JUDGING:**

- 1. The Superintendent of the Youth Poultry & Egg Show will display the eggs by a photograph and the results will be posted in the poultry tent.
- 2. The eggs become the property of the Show.
- 3. The top 3 dozen eggs for each group Pee wee, small, large, extra-large, jumbo and white, brown eggs and blue/green will receive ribbons.



#### PREMIUMS:

- o \$5.00 Blue Ribbon
- o \$3.00 Red Ribbon
- o \$2.00 White Ribbon
- o \$5.00 Best dozen eggs
- o \$5.00 Best Overall Dozen
- o Cloverbud entries exhibited will receive a participation ribbon.

#### CLASS:

- o The Poultry Judge will separate eggs into a class according to the size.
  - o Pee Wee (XSmall) eggs shall average not less than 15 ounces per dozen.
  - o Small eggs shall average not less than 18 ounces per dozen.
  - o Medium eggs shall average not less than 21 ounces per dozen. Large eggs shall average not less than 24 ounces per dozen.
  - o Extra Large eggs shall average not less than 27 ounces per dozen.
  - o Jumbo eggs shall average not less than 30 ounces perdozen.

  - Must be turned in at time of check-in.
- o May be decorated with paint, feathers, paper, crayons, yarn, etc.
- o Posters must be completed by the exhibitor.

## Section 13 | Master Exhibitor & Good Neighbor Award

- Please plan to attend the Poultry Workshop (see event calendar for date/time) for more information and to receive a skill-a-thon booklet.
- Adults & Youth please sign in & out each time in the poultry tent. By doing so
  points earned towards Master Exhibitor as well as community service hours are
  tracked for youth organizations and adults time for Community Service
  involvement for possible grants. Youth must sign in order to receive points.
   Parent cannot sign for youth. Ensure last name is included.
- All exhibitors are automatically entered.
- Extra points earned for barn duty of minimum of 2 hours at a time. (No points given if work 1 hr 59 minutes sorry).
- Points are earned and tabulated with highest two (2) scores will receive Master Exhibitor-\$50 and Reserve Master Exhibitor-\$25.
- Each section gets points; a percentage of the points is used towards the total accumulated points:

#### Showmanship 40% | Skillathon 40% | Informational Poster 15% | Egg Decorating 5%

- Barn Duty-time is calculated by signing in & out as well as consideration for the GOOD NEIGHBOR AWARD. Those who do 2 hours at a time of barn duty will receive EXTRA POINTS
- Demonstrations-Each demonstration to be 5-10 minutes long each in front of group of 4 or more. Youth may do more than one:
  - 1-2 demos, 5 points each 3-5 demos 2 points each
