



BMX BIKES, BOARDS, AND BLADES STUNT SHOW - With the average show lasting 30 minutes in length, the teeth clenching stunt bike show is full of the back flips, front flips, 360's, 540's and gliding spinning stunts! This BMX Stunt Team leaves a positive and lasting impression with our spectators long after the show is over. This stunt show features the world's most extreme bicycle stunt riders in a spectacular, non-stop, action-packed show.

<u>GREAT AMERICAN FRONTIER SHOW</u> – Our Nations heritage comes alive through the excitement of the Great American Frontier Show. A tribute to the frontier people and animals that built America! Much more than an extraordinary entertainment package, these shows feature demonstrations of natural animal behavior, wildlife and environmental conservations, and the do's and don'ts of human interaction with wild animals, all while demonstrating the old-fashioned value of our ancestors who founded our great country.

<u>BEAUTY PAGEANT COMPETITIONS</u> It doesn't get any more nostalgic than the annual Fairest of the Fair beauty pageant competitions. This annual spectator favorite includes 3 days of pageants for a multitude of age groups (Baby/Toddlers, Petite Miss, Little Miss, Teen Miss, Fairest of the Fair and even a Senior Pageant for contestants 55 and over). Each contestant brings a swarm of friends and family to cheer them on in this annual tradition. The winner of the Fairest of the Fair competition represents Williamson County in the State Fairest of the Fair pageant.

<u>FAIR MAPS - This opportunity is an excellent way to literally put your company's name in every hundreds of thousands of people's hands. It is very tough to navigate 80 acres of fun and entertainment without a map which is why every fairgoer will use one during their visit. Handheld and poster size display maps are available throughout the Fair site, as well as on the internet, and in hundred of thousands of Fair Guide Magazines, newspaper inserts, and Fair Programs.</u>

<u>VOLUNTEER LOUNGE</u> – The *Volunteer Lounge* is an air-conditioned area that serves as the on-site headquarters for the Fair's 1600(+) volunteers. During the Fair, this area will be open every hour of the Fair providing an air-conditioned area for the Volunteers to relax as well as providing free snacks and beverages. Make an impact on these volunteers who are donating their time at the Fair. This opportunity includes title sponsorship of the Volunteer Lounge and potentially a Volunteer Appreciation Party.

<u>FAIR DAILY SHEETS</u> — Daily Sheets are brightly colored pamphlets which showcases the Fair's entertainment line-up and highlights events and programs. Daily Sheets are a daily update of what's happening at the Fair. Several thousand are printed each day and distributed to each entrance during all (9) days of the fair.

<u>AWARDS, TROPHYS, PLAQUES</u> – This is an excellent opportunity for a sponsor to attach themselves to a real "feel good" part of the Fair. Throughout the Fair, thousands of fair contestants will be competing for approximately 1,000 different ribbons, trophies, and plaques. Each award will tagged with a card recognizing the sponsor as making the awards possible by being the "Official Award Provider" of the Fair along with the sponsor's logo as well as a congratulatory note from the sponsor.

About Franklin, Tennessee:

Easily accessible via Interstate 65, Franklin is located in the heart of Middle Tennessee, a scenic and cultural treasure of beautiful rolling countryside woven intricately with quaint small towns, metropolitan landscapes and a rich heritage of traditions. Franklin was incorporated in 1799, having been named after the inventor and scientist Ben Franklin. In the years prior to the Civil War, Williamson County was one of the wealthiest counties in Tennessee and Franklin was the center with its thriving plantation economy.




...demographics
