IMPORTANT. Please check your dog's NADAC registration number on your trial confirmation as soon as you receive it; also, please check the copy of the results posted at the trial. You should report any errors to the Trial Secretary immediately.

NADAC records trial results as they are submitted by the host clubs/groups. The individual trial results submitted by the club are uploaded to the www.NADACForum.com within two weeks after the NADAC office receives them from the club. Please accept the responsibility to review those results, and check that your registration number and qualifying points, as reported by the club, are correct. You can join the Forum by going to www.NADACForum.com and submitting your request. If you find an error in the reporting of your dog's qualifying points or registration number, please contact the host club. The host club is responsible for correcting any errors and informing NADAC.

Levels. Points earned at a higher level of a class, prior to the completion of the lower level title, will not be recorded by NADAC for future use. If a dog earns points in a level of a class that they are not eligible to title in, those points will not be added to the dog's records.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, including but not limited to the following rules regarding entry, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of the trial.

The current Jump Height Table, Breed Exemption List, description of classes, levels and divisions are included in the current Exhibitors Handbook. A copy of the current Exhibitors Handbook may be downloaded free of charge from the NADAC website: www.nadac.com.

• **Dogs must be registered and** have a valid registration number before entries will be accepted. Request numbers at: <http://nadac.com/afm/dogregfrm.asp>

• No leads, collars, food, toys, balls, clickers or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course at any time. No food, toys, balls or other training devices may be used within ten (10) feet of the ring entrance. Exhibitors **may** carry food or non audible toys inside their pockets, **inside a closed container** such as a zip lock bag into the ring. The food/toys may not be visible to the judge and may not be pointed out to the dog while in the ring. Food may not be giving to the dog in the ring or within 10 feet outside the ring.

• We use the Agility Unscrambled program which allows e-mail confirmations and results dissemination. Please make sure your email address on the entry form is legible. We will send out electronic confirmations prior to the trial date and electronic results after the date of the trial.

• Safety shall always be the foremost consideration in actions and conduct by dogs and handlers at all times.

• All healthy, trained dogs over eighteen (18) months of age are eligible to compete in NADAC agility trials. Bitches in heat, lame or blind dogs are ineligible for entry, as is any dog with a deformity which may cause a judge to not be able to reasonably assess the dog's ability to function and perform agility obstacles safely, and in a manner that is in the best interest, health and welfare of the dog.

• Any dog that demonstrates aggression towards any person or any dog whether inside the ring or outside the ring, may be excused from the agility trial. Any dog which the judge feels is not in enough control to perform all obstacles in a safe manner may be excused from the agility trial.

- The trial Committee may refuse any entry on the basis expressly provided through NADAC rules and regulations or guidelines established by NADAC. Anyone currently not in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed entry into the trial.

- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$25 service charge for returned checks.

- There shall be no refunds in the event that the dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a judge or the club, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. In addition, no entry fees will be refunded in the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strike, or any other cause beyond the control of the Club.

- A refund up to 75% will be made if a Veterinarian's certificate of proof of injury or illness of the dog or a bitch in heat is submitted to the Trial Secretary prior to check-in on the first day of the trial.

- All exhibitors are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s) and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog(s) and/or children engage in disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such a case no refund of entries will be made.

- The Club, its agents or assignees will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result was by accident or any other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.

- Dogs must be on leash anywhere on the show grounds property, or in crates when not competing in the ring. No dogs may be tied to fences, cars, trees or other obstacles at any time. Use of prong collars is not permitted at any time and will result in the owner being asked to replace the collar immediately.

- Measuring: Dogs which require measuring:
Dogs in the Proficient Category, Novice, Open or Elite jumping 4", 8", 12" or 16"

Dogs which do not need to be measured:

- Dogs jumping 16" in the Veteran or Junior Handler Division
- Dogs jumping 20" and
- Dogs in the Skilled Category
- Dogs with a permanent height card
- Dogs listed on the Height Exemption List

Categories & Jump Heights

Each class contains two categories, Skilled & Proficient. A dog may only be entered in ONE category per weekend. In the Skilled Category, dogs must jump 4" lower than indicated by the current jump height table. (no dog may jump lower than 4") In the Regular Agility Class, dogs incurring 5 or fewer faults, earn a 5 point qualifying round. *(Please refer to www.nadac.com for the latest information and explanation of the Skilled and Proficient categories).*

There are five Standard Division-Proficient jump heights: 8", 12", 16", 20".
There are four Standard Division-Skilled jump heights: 4", 8", 12", and 16".
There are four jump heights for the Veterans and Junior Handler Division: 4", 8", 12", and 16".

Note: In EGC there are no Vet/VH/Breed Exemptions. Your dog will be entered in their Proficient Standard Division Jump Height.

As of January-2014: Dogs must enter the Veterans Division in all jumping classes after their 9th birthday. After their 12th birthday, dogs must enter the Skilled Category, Veterans Division for jumping classes and Skilled Category for non-jumping classes.

Handlers who are 60 years or older, or who have a disability that restricts mobility, may choose to enter the non-jumping classes as a Veteran Handler and receive 10% more standard course time. This option is for Veteran/Disabled Handlers in the non-jumping classes only. The Veteran/Disabled Handler Division is designed for handlers due to age or impairment, are mobility limited and need extra time to guide their canine partners through an agility course.

When entering as a Veteran/Disabled Handler, you must enter all dogs in all classes for the entire trial in this Division and jump 4" lower than your Standard Division jump height requires. In the non-jumping classes, dogs will be scored and placed with their Standard Division jump height.

DOUBLE RUN FORMAT

Exhibitors run the same course twice. Rounds 1 and 2 are run back to back, with only one walk thru. You will be able to earn Q's in each run.

1. As used here "NADAC" means the North American Dog Agility Council, LLC, its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.
2. Exhibitor/owner agrees to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.
3. Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.
4. Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the floors, stairways, halls, lighting, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fittings, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.
5. Exhibitor/owner releases NADAC (including NADAC officers, directors, employees, and members), Kern Canine Activities - KCA (including its board, officers, agents, and show committee) and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises.
