Hunter Over Fences

Each horse will individually negotiate a course consisting of at least 8 jumps over a minimum of 4 different obstacles. At least one change of direction is recommended. The hunter should provide his rider with a safe, consistent ride at a working pace over a course of fences similar to those that might be encountered in the field. This requires that all horses must be serviceably sound and any horse showing evidence of lameness, broken wind or impairment of vision will be excused from the ring by the steward, show vet or judge.

Maximum time 60 seconds per obstacle, judges are encouraged to advance on to the next obstacle any horse taking excessive time at an obstacle. Horse to be penalized for any unnecessary delay or excessive time at object. Refusals do not constitute class disqualifications.

Horses will negotiate obstacles with style and consistency. Credit will be given to horses that show the capability of picking their way through the course when obstacles warrant it, and willingly respond to the rider's cues on more difficult obstacles. Horses with artificial appearance over obstacles will be penalized. The course must be designed to show appropriate gait differences (walk, jog/trot, lope/canter, halt, back). A minimum of 6 obstacles will be used. Time in excess of 30 seconds or 3 attempts in approaching an obstacle will eliminate the score for the obstacle and the rider will proceed to the next obstacle. The class will be judged on the performance of the horse over obstacles, with emphasis on manners, response to the rider and attitude. This class may be ridden in either English or Western tack or attire but not a combination of both.

Horses will negotiate obstacles with style and consistency. Credit will be given to horses that show the capability of picking their way through the course when obstacles warrant it, and willingly respond to the rider's cues on more difficult obstacles. Horses with artificial appearance over obstacles will be penalized. The course must be designed to show appropriate gait differences (walk, jog/trot, lope/canter, halt, back). A minimum of 6 obstacles will be used. Time in excess of 30 seconds or 3 attempts in approaching an obstacle will eliminate the score for the obstacle and the rider will proceed to the next obstacle. The class will be judged on the performance of the horse over obstacles, with emphasis on manners, response to the rider and attitude. In Hand Suitability

This class judges the communication between handler and equine. Handlers will enter the ring at a walk while going the first way of the ring. Entries will be asked to follow given commands on the rail both ways of the ring that may include walking, trotting, stopping, backing and turning at any gait. Handlers and equine will also be asked to execute a pattern. Patterns may include any of the above gaits as well as ground tying. Equines and handlers will be judged 70% on suitability as a team in communication and execution of rail work, 15% on pattern completion and 15% on presentation of both handler and equine.

Hunter Over Fences
