

BREEDING BEEF DIVISION

In County Heifers Only

Arrival Time – Friday, **March 31st**, 10:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.

Check-In – Friday, **March 31st** from 5:00 p.m. – 7:00 p.m.

Judging Date – Sunday, April **2nd**, 9:00 a.m.

THIS IS A HEIFER SHOW ONLY – NO BULLS

1. This division is subject to the General Rules and these Division rules.
2. Open to all 4-H and FFA members that are enrolled in public, private, parochial schools or Home Educated students. If an exhibitor requires a General Exception Form (refer to Page 2), it will be due on January **3, 2017**. Each application will be reviewed for compliance.
3. A copy of heifer's registration papers are required with entry on February **24th**.
4. Grand and Reserve banners will be awarded to overall show winners. Grand and Reserve Belt Buckles will be awarded to division winners. Showmanship jackets will be awarded. Rosettes will be given to Champion and Reserve Breed Champions.
 - a. All others will receive ribbons.
 - b. The Fair Association will contribute \$1500 to prize money and have a 60/40 payback on entry fees. (The 60% will go to the exhibitors, 40% to the Fair).
 - c. If only one entry in a class, 2nd place prize money will be awarded.
5. All Breeding Livestock must be owned by the exhibitor. Ownership and age of livestock must be verified either by presentation of registration papers (if livestock is registered) or by other recorded verification of their age (if livestock is not registered). Replacement Heifers are eligible to show.
6. No grooming material is allowed. This is a "Blow and Go" Show. All heifers will be shown with hair in a natural state WITHOUT the use of glues, adhesives, paints, etc. Heifers with any type of glue, paint, adhesive, etc. in the hair will be disqualified and premiums forfeited. Heifers will be toweled.
7. All breeding stock must be double-tied.
8. No bedding hay.
9. Judging will be done in the following order:

AMERICAN DIVISION – Brahman, Brahmousin, Brangus/Red Brangus, Beefmaster, Santa Gertrudis, Simbrah , ABC and ARB. The first and second place of each breed will be called back to choose the Grand and Reserve of the American Division.

ENGLISH DIVISION – Angus/Red Angus, Hereford/Polled Hereford and Shorthorn. The first and second place of each breed will be called back to choose the Grand and Reserve of the English Division.

EXOTIC DIVISION – Charolais, Chianina, Limousin, Maine Anjou, Simmental, ORB and AOB. The first and second place of each breed will be called back to choose the Grand and Reserve of the Exotic Division.

Breeds will be broken down into the following classes:

Up to 10 months - born through **5/30/16**

10 to 14 months – born **2/1/16** through **5/31/16**

14 to 18 months – born **10/1/15** through **1/31/16**

18 to 24 months – born 4/1/15 through 9/30/15
24 to 31 months – born 9/1/14 through 3/31/15

*If six (6) head of a particular breed arrive for judging then a class will be set up for them, based on entry due date.

10. ENTRIES MUST BE COMPLETED BY FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 24, 2017 BY 5:00 P.M. WITH A \$20.00 ENTRY FEE PER HEAD.

11. BREEDING BEEF ENTRIES WILL BE RELEASED IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING THE BREEDING BEEF SHOW ON SUNDAY, APRIL 2nd.

12. There will be one stall assigned per entry (heifer). Said entry (heifer) and exhibitor has right of occupancy and/or use of only the single assigned stall space. The Committee reserves the right to police stalls at any time to determine if any non-assigned stall space should be filled. Exceptions to this rule will be considered on a case by case basis to be determined by the Chairman.

JR. AND SR. SHOWMANSHIP IS OPEN TO ALL EXHIBITORS WHO WISH TO PARTICIPATE. YOU PAY \$5.00 (CASH) AT THE ENTRY GATE AND THE WINNER WILL BE AWARDED ALL PROCEEDS AT THE EXIT GATE.
