This is an inexpensive 10% all natural protein, textured sweet feed containing corn, oats and grain byproducts. It is designed to supplement all classes of livestock grazing average to good quality pasture, including cattle, horses, donkeys, and goats. It contains the proper levels of macro minerals, including calcium and phosphorus, trace minerals and the fat-soluble vitamins A, D, and E. This feed is designed to supplement your other feeds in making a complete feeding program. This feed is an excellent product to use when wanting to catch and work your livestock. This feed is also an excellent way to get cattle started on feed before changing them to feeds such as Formax Grower, Formax Developer, or a pelleted feed.

Important Management Practices:

Provide a source of fresh clean water and free choice minerals at all times. When making changes to an animal's diet, expect a 7 to 10-day transition period for the animals. Do not allow feed to become wet or moldy. When feeding as a hay supplement, provide bunk feeders to reduce waste. Always provide free choice to hay or other forage when feeding this product. NOTE: This product contains slightly more than 30 parts per million Copper and is NOT recommended for sheep.
