Rules:

1. Only wine made by non professional wine makers allowed.
2. All entries must be checked in by 5:00 p.m., Saturday, September 30, 2017. Entries can be mailed or hand delivered to 2600 Howard Street, Little Rock, AR 72206
3. Each entry consists of one (1) 750ML bottles. No wines will be returned.
4. Entry fees: \$5.00 per entry. The entry fee money will go towards the Dr. Justin Morris Scholarship Fund.
5. Entry form and fees must accompany the wine at the time of submission.
6. Prizes to be awarded:
First, Second and Third Ribbons in each class.
“Best of Show” Ribbon for each division.
Grand Champion Silver Tray for the Best Wine. The judging of the wine will be Sunday, October 22, 2017, starting at 2:00 p.m.
7. A pass for admission and parking will be mailed back to you, so you and come and watch your wine being judged.

The wine may be entered as an Arkansas Grown Amateur Wine
or
Not Arkansas Grown Amateur Wine.

AVA Amateur Wine – The grapes and fruits used in making the wine must be grown in Arkansas

Not AVA Amateur Wine – The grapes, fruits or concentrates used in making the wine not grown in Arkansas
