

BEFORE USING TRAIL EACH TRAIL RIDER MUST:

Register at Park Office, obtain Trail Pass and rules. Each rider must have one. Users must present proof of current negative Coggins Test for each horse.

Our 12.5 mile (20.12 km) Trail is routed through a natural setting, so please use caution. To prevent injury to yourself or others, pay attention to your surroundings. Be aware of possible hazards, including wildlife, and other unpredictable situations including other riders, both equestrian and/or bike.

Use at your own risk. LNRA is not responsible for accidents. All riders are to stay on the designated trail.

Trail will close 30 minutes before sunset. Be aware of Trail Hours and allow enough time for the return trip to the Trailhead before it closes. Mile markers are located along the trail for reference purposes.

Motorized vehicles are not allowed on the trail.

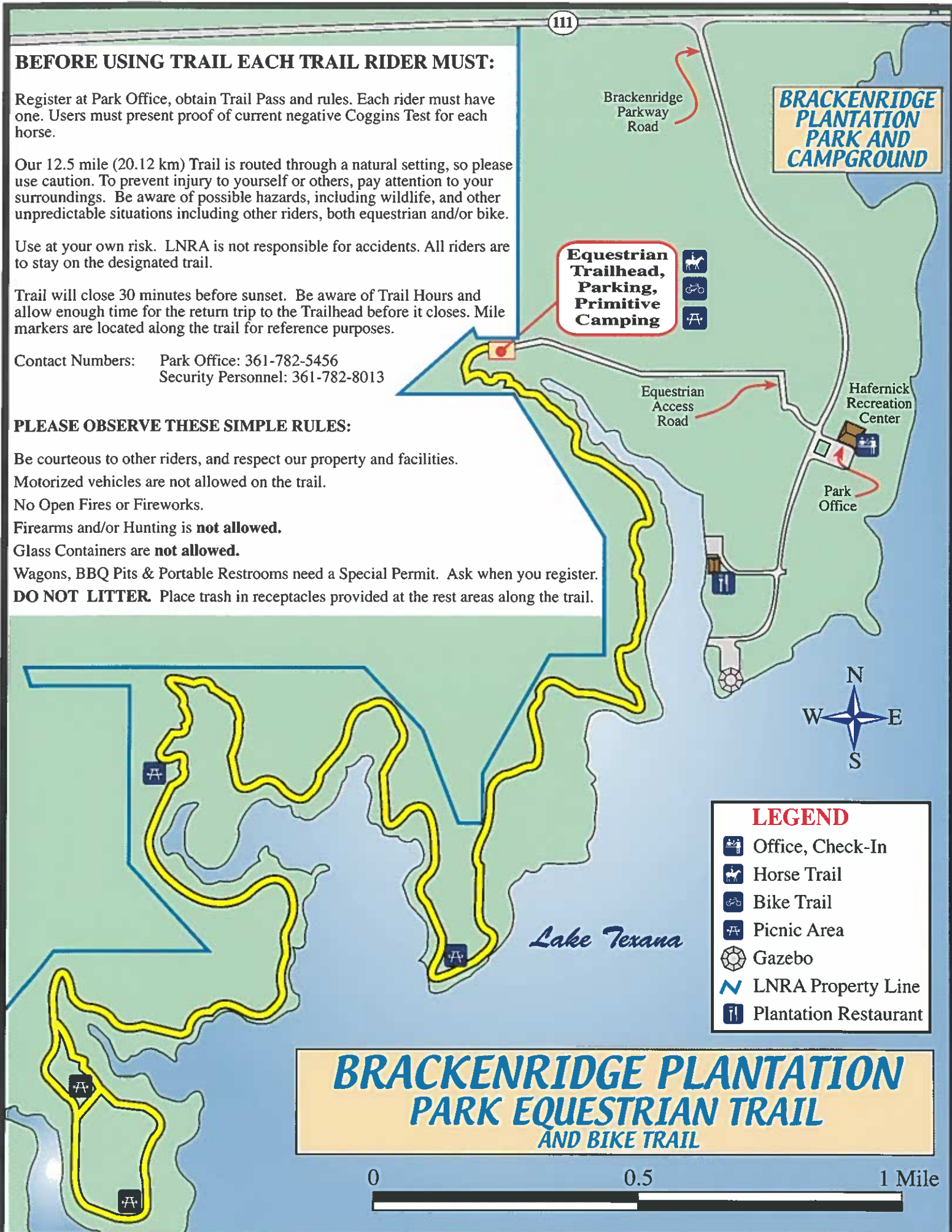
No Open Fires or Fireworks.
