STEPPENWOLF AND EN VOGUE TO APPEAR AT THE FAIR

Legendary rock band Steppenwolf and one of the most popular R&B groups of all time have been signed to perform at the Central Washington State Fair in September.

John Kay and Steppenwolf will be performing on Thursday, September 28 at 7 p.m. at the Fair. Powered by Kay's gritty vocals, Steppenwolf's blues-based rock burst onto the scene in the summer of 1968. The band has had a number of hits including the timeless classics "*Born To Be Wild*," "*Magic Carpet Ride*," "*The Pusher*," and "*Rock Me*."

On the following night, Friday, September 29, Pop/R&B group **En Vogue** will perform at the Fair at 7:30 p.m. Recognized as one of the top five highest selling American female music groups in history, En Vogue has sold over 20 million albums and has amassed over 30 million streams and over 26 million YouTube views on their top six hit singles alone: the R&B and Pop smashes *Hold On*, *Free Your Mind*, *Never Gonna Get It*, *Giving Him Something He Can Feel*, *Don't Let Go*, and *Whatta Man feat. Salt N Pepa*).

General admission bleacher seats for these concerts, and all the entertainers in the U.S. Cellular Concert Series, are free with admission to the Fair, however a limited amount of reserved seating is available for purchase for all performances. Reserve tickets for John Kay & Steppenwolf are \$24 & \$18, and reserved tickets for En Vogue are \$14 & \$9. Tickets can be purchased beginning Wednesday morning, April 12, at 10 a.m. through the State Fair Park Box Office, all TicketsWest outlets, www.ticketwest.com and charge-by-phone at 800.325.7328 (SEAT). Reserved seat tickets do not include Fair admission.
