COMPETITION REQUIREMENTS

1. All entrants must have read and be familiar with the Colorado State Fair General Terms and Conditions, General Livestock Competition Requirements, and Health Requirements. When applicable all association rules shall apply.
2. All entrants for livestock exhibited in Open, Breed, or Market competitions shall provide a premises identification number at the time of entry.
3. There will be no outside bedding allowed on the State Fairgrounds. The Colorado State Fair Management is making it mandatory for all exhibitors to purchase their animal bedding through the Colorado State Fair Feed/Bedding Concessionaire. If you choose to violate this rule and bring your own bedding, you will be asked to remove it from the grounds immediately! This rule will be highly enforced by the Colorado State Fair Management team.
4. Cattle registered with either the International Miniature Zebu Association and/or the American Miniature Zebu Association are welcome to participate at the Colorado State Fair.
5. The International Miniature Zebu Association and the National Zebu Cattle Club (NZCC) approve this show and classes. All Cattle will be judged according to the IMZA rules and regulation along with IMZA scorecard and faulting sheets. The shows held at the Colorado State Fair will pursue the “Official IMZA show policy of rules and regulations”. Each animal shown must be registered with the either the American Miniature Zebu Association or the International Miniature Zebu Association. A copy of the original certificate of registration must be presented to the superintendent prior to the CSF show and kept available at all times during the show for each animal exhibited.
6. The National Zebu Cattle Club offers 25% of the total premiums including Champion classes. The Colorado State Fair will pay 75% in premiums including Grand Champion classes. The Colorado State Fair will credit \$5.00 per animal paid entry back to the NZCC after the completion of the fair.
7. Proof of birth date shall be the birth date on the animal’s registration certificate. The base date for computing the age of the animal shall be the day before the animal is to be judged. An animal may be judged in only one age class. Owner is responsible for entering animal in correct class. There is no minimum or maximum age restriction.
8. All animals showing in any of the three Champion Challenge classes must be pre-entered (no entry fee required).

9. Original registration papers must be available for inspection at the show. Proof of ownership shall be the name on the registration certificate, unless ownership has changed within 90 day of the show.
10. Animals presented to the judge are to be washed, brushed, and combed. All Miniature Zebu must be shown in their natural state. The only clipping allowed for cattle shown is inner ear, genitalia and whiskers. No body clipping is allowed. No paint, dye, chalk or glitter may be used to modify appearance. Only clear polish may be used on hoofs and horns. Tail switch cannot be embellished in any way; no additions to the switch may be added. The alteration of physical features and appearance of any animal by cosmetic and/or surgical means are deemed unethical practices and will be grounds for disqualification. See General Livestock Competition Requirements regarding unethical practices
11. The show management reserves the right to disqualify and remove any animal from competition that is deemed unmanageable and entry fees shall be forfeited.
12. Cattle will be received through Livestock Gate #4 (off Mesa Ave) and will be housed in the Livestock Barn pens and tie-rails. Holding pens are reserved for pen entries only. Upon arrival please be patient with the concentrated effort of all crews.
