The art exhibit is open to all residents of the Four States Area. Professional artists will judge the exhibits.

- RULE 1. All work must be original work of the artist; no craft or hobby kits will be accepted.
- RULE 2. Work shown in the Fair here in previous years will not be accepted and work must not be over three years old.
- RULE 3. ABSOLUTELY NO WET PAINTINGS ACCEPTED.
- RULE 4. All pictures must be either framed or mounted on mats and wire attached for hanging. Name, phone number, address of owner and title of picture must be attached to the back of each exhibit in the upper left hand corner. All entries will be hung for judging and displayed by the Fine Arts Committee. Any entry that comes apart will be removed from the exhibition. The Fair will not be responsible for those that are improperly matted, framed or prepared for hanging. Liability to accidental frame damage is limited to cost of repair, when possible, or replacement cost. If entrant cannot be contacted, the Fair Association will have article repaired within the limits stated. The Fair Association will not be responsible for damage due to high humidity.
- RULE 5. Entries will be accepted at the Fine Arts Building at the Fairgrounds between 3:00 and 6:00 PM on Wednesday, 9/6/17 before the fair. No entries will be accepted after the designated time.
- RULE 6. Entries must remain in place until Monday, after the fair. Entries must be picked up on this date between the hours of 3:00 PM and 6:00 PM ALL ENTRIES NOT PICKED UP AT THIS TIME WILL BE CHARGED \$5 PER ITEM FOR STOREAGE FEES! Four States Fair is not responsible for articles not picked up at the designated time and date.
- RULE 7. Anyone 18 years or older may enter this show.
- RULE 8. Only INDIVIDUAL entries will be accepted.
- RULE 9. A \$3.00 entry fee will be charged for each painting.
- RULE 10. The Fair Association reserves the right to prohibit the entry of any painting they deem inappropriate for family oriented exhibition.
- RULE 11. The Fair Association will not insure any entry for over \$500.00.
- RULE 12. Ribbons will be awarded in each class and will be placed on winning entries after judging. Ribbons and awards are listed below.
- RULE 13. Any damage incurred to art entered at the Four States Fair must be reported by 5:30 PM, Monday after the fair.
- RULE 14. No one will be allowed in the building while judging is in progress.
- RULE 15. Entry into competition indicates entrant has read, understood and agreed to abide by all rules stated.

- RULE 5. Sculpture, wall hangings, textiles and ceramics will be judged in one mixed media category.
- RULE 6. Name, full address, phone number, school grade in which the art was completed, and title of art entry must be clearly written on the back of each exhibit.
- RULE 7. Ribbons will be placed on winning entries after judging.
