DO NOT BRING ARTICLES NOT LISTED

- RULE 1 All entries must be canned in the last year by the exhibitor.
- RULE 2 Canned products must be shown in standard canning jars with new two piece lids. All canned products must be sealed. Four ounce jars will not be accepted.
- RULE 3 All persons exhibiting must check in their exhibit on Wednesday before the Fair between 3PM and 6PM. Exhibits must remain in place until 3PM the Monday following the Fair. Four States Fair Management is not responsible for items not called for by 6PM Monday after the Fair.
- RULE 4 Please be certain that all of your entry tags include your name and an item description if the item is to be entered in the Miscellaneous class.

SCORECARDS USED FOR JUDGING THESE ENTRIES ARE FROM THE USDA GUIDELINES FOR JUDINGS, AND CONTENTS ARE JUDGED AS FOLLOWS:

- ¼ inch head space for jams and jellies
- ½ inch head space for fruits, pickles and tomatoes processed in a water bath canner
- 1 to 1 ¼ inch head space for vegetables and other products processed in a pressure canner
