“SCHOOL DAYS” RULES

REGISTRATION

- Fill out the registration form completely
- Include an email address and cell number so we can keep you updated
- Choose the best day for your visit – please keep in mind that it is difficult to reschedule an approved day
- One School Days visit per class unless approved by Expo NM
- No more than one chaperone per student
- Expo NM will email a confirmation receipt and final approval of your registration
- Expo NM will email a “teacher’s packet” with parking and entry info before the Fair
- Call or email if your class cannot make it on the approved day

DAY OF VISIT

- Arrive at your scheduled time
- Contact a School Days staffer upon arrival
- Stay on the bus until your staffer greets you
- Tell your staff how many students and chaperones are in your group
- Each student will be given a wristband which they must wear all day
- Each group of students and chaperones must enter together in single file
- Students and chaperones arriving after their group has entered must pay admission fee
- Smoking is prohibited
- Teachers and chaperones are asked to maintain supervision of students at all times while at the Fair to ensure a positive experience for all participants

Each year thousands of students participate in “School Days” at the State Fair. “School Days” students learn about our great state’s heritage and diverse cultures. They visit art exhibits, animal exhibits, and agriculture exhibits. They participate in a scavenger hunt, see the spectaculars, and have fun while learning! It’s a great experience!
