Cilantro Chicken Salad

Ingredients:

- 7 oz cooked chicken breasts (shredded or diced)
- 2 tablespoons light mayonnaise
- 1 scallion (small chopped)
- 2 teaspoons lime juice
- 2 tablespoons chopped cilantro
- Salt
- Pepper
- 1 pinch each-garlic powder, cumin and chile powder
- Low sodium chicken broth

Directions:

Combine chicken, mayonnaise, scallions, lime juice, and cilantro. Season to taste with salt, pepper, garlic powder, cumin, and chile powder. Add a little chicken broth if chicken seams too dry, 1 tbsp at a time.
